3 ) Tim has 37 violet balloons, he gave Sam 10 of the balloons.
How many violet balloons does he now have?

4 ) Tom decided to sell all of his old books. He gathered up 16 books to sell.
He sold 15 books in a yard sale. How many books does Tom now have?
5) Tim has ninety - six muffins, which he needs to box up into dozens. How many boxes does he need?

6 ) Nancy grew thirty - two watermelons, but the rabbits ate thirty - one watermelons. How many watermelons does Nancy have left?

7 ) There were a total of 8 hockey games in the season.
The season is played for 4 months. How many hockey games were played each month, if each month has the same number of games?

8 ) Melanie has nineteen orange marbles. Tom has forty - seven times more orange marbles than Melanie. How many orange marbles does Tom have?

9 ) Keith has saved 2100 cents from selling lemonade. How many dollars does Keith have?

10 ) Melanie had eleven quarters in her bank. Her dad gave her twenty - five more quarters. How many quarters does Melanie have now?
